



Advance Works Notification – Vegetation Removal

About us

The Hornsea Three wind farm received development consent in December 2020. Hornsea Three once complete, could provide clean power to over three million UK homes. It will make a significant contribution towards meeting the UK's net zero commitments and we're committed to working closely with stakeholders and local communities as we take the project forward.

Upcoming Works

Vegetation Removal

In order to prepare for the future construction of the Hornsea Three Wind Farm, we will be carrying out vegetation removal along the Hornsea Three cable route. Clearing vegetation is a necessary part of our work and we'll be carrying out this work from North to South along the cable route.

We'll begin this work on weekdays from **Tuesday 11th October 2022** until **Friday 20 January 2023** between 0700 and 1800. Our teams will be on site one hour before and one hour after the works to set up and secure work areas at the end of each day.

Works are currently planned to take place in the following districts between the dates listed below:

District	Date
North Norfolk District Council	Tuesday 11 October to Wednesday 2 November 2022
Broadlands District Council	Thursday 10 November to Thursday 1 December 2022
South Norfolk District Council	Friday 9 December to Friday 20 January 2023

Ecological surveys will be completed prior to the start of the works and all work will be carried out under the watching brief of an ecologist. The vegetation will be removed with mechanical plant (excavator/tractor), handheld strimmer, chainsaw, hedge cutter and other hand tools.

What to expect

- You might see us working on site during the day.
- Some low-level noise from onsite machinery during working hours.

- Keep all sites safe and secure, while keeping disruption to a minimum.
