


Help us to plan a new community at Honingham Thorpe

15th - 29th November 2021



Latimer is seeking early public input into the vision for a new settlement near the villages of Honingham, Easton and Colton, to the west of Norwich.

Honingham Thorpe would deliver around 4,000 new homes, thousands of jobs, schools, a country park, other leisure uses and more.

The emerging Greater Norwich Local Plan states that a new settlement is likely to be required in the future to help meet the area's housing need. Honingham Thorpe is identified at Policy 7.6 as a potentially suitable location, although a new settlement is unlikely to be allocated until a future review of the Local Plan.

Have your say

We are pleased to invite you to take part in our initial public consultation, where we will seek your ideas for what you would like to see delivered at Honingham Thorpe. This feedback will be used to help us develop proposals that can feed into any consideration of a new settlement in a future Local Plan review – it is important to note that we are not preparing or submitting a planning application. Planning Background

Norwich City, Broadland District, South Norfolk District and Norfolk County Council are working together to develop a joint Local Plan. The Greater Norwich Local Plan is a framework for the future development of the partner council areas and will shape how these areas grow between now and 2038.

The emerging Local Plan shows that the population of Greater Norwich will continue to grow in the years ahead, with more than 40,000 new homes required over the next 27 years. Whilst the emerging Plan

does not currently identify a location for any new settlements, it notes that Honingham Thorpe is a potentially suitable location.

The partner Councils are due to begin a review of the options for a new settlement next year, with a view to potentially allocating a new settlement at a future Local Plan review. Ahead of this, we want your input on our emerging ideas for the site, in order to co-create a vision for Honingham Thorpe.
